

6. The Customer is responsible for preparing the vehicle for transport by doing the following: Making sure that the key is in the ignition and making sure the vehicle is in the proper state for shipment.

7. Old School allows personal property to be securely stored if Customer advises Old School prior to pickup. **However, the insurance will NOT cover these items.**

8. Old School **forbids** the Customer to transport any **illegal items**. Customer assumes any and all responsibility, legally as well as financially, for all actions taken against Old School in relationship to transport of any illegal items by the Customer.

9. Payment in full is requested at the time of pickup. A deposit is required to secure your reservation. Customer may pay by business or personal check, cash or any type of certified funds. Any balance due **must** be paid at the time of pickup. Other payment arrangements must be discussed with an Old School Rep. **before pickup**. The driver will issue a receipt at the time of payment.

10. If the customer cancels a shipment within 1 month of pickup a cancellation fee may be imposed to cover processing. If the customer cancels anytime thereafter, Old School will retain any deposits received. Please keep in mind that once a Customer reserves a spot on our trailer, we cannot sell it to anyone else.

11. Customer hereby acknowledges that Old School Transport reserves the right to pursue any avenues available, in order to collect monies due as stated in this contact. This includes, but is not limited to returned check fees.

12. Old School ensures that all information contained in this contract is confidential and information will not be sold, traded or shared with any other person or company. Old School does not purchase or release customer lists.

13. Old School reserves the right to modify the terms and conditions and shall provide Customer with thirty (30) days notice of any changes via e-mail, phone or in writing.

14. The laws of the State of Pennsylvania shall govern this Agreement. Any legal action must be filed in the Court of Common Pleas of Columbia County, PA. **By executing this agreement the Customer waives any and all rights to litigate elsewhere.**
